

## 2018 Registration Information

Fall Registration will begin on Monday June 4 and continue through July.

### Fall Registration Procedures:

1. Complete the registration and pay your fee online. The annual registration fee is \$50. This must be done before a dancer can be placed on a class list.
2. Adjustments may be made to classes after June 29<sup>th</sup>, so be sure to sign up to ensure a place in the class.

### Summer Registration Procedures:

1. Complete the registration online. Please note these session dates:
  - a. Kinderballet through Level 3 session is June 16 - August 11.
  - b. Level 4 -9 is divided into 2 separate sessions. June 18 – July 14 and July 23 – August 11.
  - c. 2-week Intensive Workshop is July 9 – July 20.

Note: There will be no Level 4 – 9 afternoon classes during the Intensive Workshop

2. You may take these classes by the week, month, or individually
3. You will not be charged in advance for Summer classes. Instead, we will bill you after the first half of the session (four weeks) for the classes you actually attended. Likewise, we will bill you after the second half of the session (four weeks) for the classes attended.
4. Please register for summer by June 16, so that adjustments can be made if necessary

## Fall Class Expectations:

Recommended classes:

Kinderballet 1 through Level 1: One class a week

Level 2: Two classes a week

Level 3: Three classes a week. Two classes are required.

Level 4: Four technique classes a week. Three technique classes are required.

Level 5 and up: Five classes per week. Four are required

in order to take pointe classes, dancers must take three technique classes per week, and take the technique class before the pointe class ( Except for the Wednesday Pointe 2 class).

If you are not able to take the required number of classes for your level, you may stay in your current level.

We understand that during the summer you may not be able to attend as many classes as during the year. However, especially Level 4 and up should make every effort to attend as many classes as possible to maintain their skills over the summer.

## Class Colors

Kinderballet through Level 5 dancers may wear any leotard style in their class color. The leotard should be as simple as possible. Attached skirts are not recommended.

Kinderballet 1 and 2	Light Pink Leotard
Kinderballet 3 and 4	Light Blue Leotard
Level 1	Dark or Forest Green Leotard
Level 2	Red Leotard
Level 3	Lavender Leotard
Level 4	Burgundy Leotard
Level 5	Royal, or Marine Blue Leotard

Level 6 through Level 8 black leotards, and the class color belt. The leotard is to be a simple, traditional style leotard with no stylized backs or shoulder straps.

Level 6 Lavender Belt

Level 7 Yellow Belt

Level 8 Red Belt  
Level 9 White Belt  
Level 10 White Belt

Level 9 Lavender Leotard  
Level 10 Aqua Leotard

The leotard is to be a simple, traditional style leotard with no stylized backs of shoulder straps.
